Kaikoura (/ k a ? ? k ? ? r ? /; M?ori: "Kaik?ura", from "Te Ahi Kaik?ura a Tama ki te Rangi") is a town on the east coast of the South Island of New Zealand. It is located on State Highway 1, 180 km north of Christchurch. Kaikoura became the first local authority in the Southern Hemisphere to achieve recognition by the EarthCheck Community Standard.
